Athletic Paper Work

Each student athlete **MUST** have a current physical and athletic paperwork completed, notarized, and turned in to the Discipline Office, by January 22, 2018. All paper work can be found and downloaded from the Crestview High School Web site. Please submit all **completed** paper work to Mrs. Wendy Rodriguez in the Discipline Office, and she will then provide you with a **confirmation slip** that you are required to provide to your coach before tryouts and practice.

Tennis Tryouts and Practice Schedule

Tryouts are scheduled for January 22 and 23, 2018. Bring your own tennis racket, water-bottle, and please wear court shoes.

Tennis practice sessions begin January 22, 2018, and practice will be held daily from Monday through Friday from 2:20 pm until 4:30 pm. Practice will continue until the end of the tennis season on April 14 (District tournament is April 16-21, 2018).

Grades

Each Tennis player must have and maintain a 2.0 GPA throughout the tennis season. Any player with a GPA below a 2.5 will be required to attend tutoring sessions at least twice a week. Tutoring is held Tuesday, and Thursday from 2:20 p.m. to 3:20 p.m. Additionally, students with poor grades will not be allowed school leave for away matches or

tournaments. For example, a tennis player with two "Ds" or one "F" is not qualified for student leave and will not be allowed to travel or play with the team.

Discipline

If a player accumulates three or more discipline referrals during the season, he/she will be removed from the team.

Tennis Teams

The top five girls and the top five boys will be designated as varsity tennis team players for Crestview High School tennis matches and tournaments. Five single matches and two doubles teams for both girls and boys will be scheduled to play against six high schools in Florida State Class 3A (Region 1, District D2). Our district includes the following high schools: Niceville High School, Choctaw High School, Ft. Walton Beach High School, Leon High School Tallahassee, Lincoln High School Tallahassee, and Chiles High School Tallahassee. Tennis players will play approximately nine to ten matches and a district tournament during the 2018 Tennis season. Tennis team members who do not seed, or place, in the top five will compete at the junior varsity level. The coach will offer every opportunity possible for all tennis players to play against opposing teams during Tennis Matches. Please do not be discouraged if opposing teams do not bring or make extra players available.

Equipment

Each tennis player is responsible for owning his/her own tennis court shoes, primary tennis racket and a back-up racket. Additionally, students are responsible for bringing a refillable water bottle.

Team uniforms will be ordered before January 11, 2018. Cost of uniforms varies between \$125.00 to \$175.00. Team uniform colors are designated as red and white; some black trim is permissible.

Membership Fee

Each Tennis player will be required to pay a one-time fee of \$75.00 in order to join the team. The fee will cover costs associated with transportation (buses to and from matches) and tennis supplies (balls, nets, court upkeep, etc.). This fee will need to be paid before March 1, 2018, or the tennis player will be placed on the CHS debt list. The fee may be mitigated or waived based on results of individual fund raising efforts. Currently, the Tennis Team volunteers to clean the football stadium during football season to raise funds. Generally, the team receives \$150.00 in funds to clean the stadium, and these funds are divided equally among Tennis Team volunteers. For example, if four volunteers report for stadium cleanup, they each receive an equal portion of those funds toward the payment of their tennis team fee. If there are any concerns with tennis fees, please feel free to contact Coach Castille.
