Crestview High School Automotive program is designed to teach students the entry level skills needed to enter the Automotive Industry from High School or continue to a Technical Training School or College. Our program strives to have a professional Shop (Lab) with the most current equipment and tools so students can get firsthand experience using the Equipment and tools used within the Industry. Our (Lab) has three 2 post lifts and each program is equipped with a Hunter alignment rack and Hawkeye system for students to become experienced in Automobile and truck alignments. Our program also has a classroom with up to date computers. The programs that are available to students are: Shop-Key Pro, SP2 (Safety Training), Selected Manufacturer On-Line Training and CDX. Our Automotive Maintenance and Light Repair Program is NATEF Certified which means that each lab, classroom and curriculum meets National Standards for High School Automotive Programs. Our program has its own “Program Advisors.” These are individuals who are in the automotive industry, previous students or parents that are willing to come to school meetings usually 4 meetings per year which meet in the evening. Advisors offer support and guidance for improving the program. If you are interested in becoming a program advisor contact the Instructor of our program.
