COVID Changes for the Clinic



- 🐾 The Clinic door will remain locked at all times.
- 🐾 Only three students will be allowed in the clinic at the same time.

- 🐾 Clinic staff will meet each student at the door for temp check, mask and they will be assessed for COVID symptoms.
- 🐾 For any student with a temp of 100.4 or higher, parents will be called for pick up, the student will be masked and wait in designated isolation area.
- 🐾 If any student presents with any of the following COVID symptoms and no preexisting condition is identified on school health card or after speaking to parents, the student will be masked and wait in designated isolation area for pick up: chills, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, fatigue/muscle or body aches, headache, new lose of smell or taste, congestion or runny nose, diarrhea, nausea, or vomiting.
- 🐾 Any student sent home with COVID-19 symptoms needs to meet **ALL** of the following criteria before returning to school:
 - 🐾 Has it been at least 10 days since student first had COVID-like symptoms?
 - 🐾 Have your student's symptoms improved significantly?
 - 🐾 Has your student been without symptoms and fever free for 24 hours (1 day) without taking any medication?

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- 🐾 If student is tested for COVID-19 and has a negative test, then they may return to school after 24 hours (1 day) with no fever or symptoms without the use of medications.
 - 🐾 If student (or household) is under 14-day self-quarantine, the above does not apply, including a negative COVID-19 test. The student may return to school at the completion of the 14-day self-quarantine.

- 🐾 Students will immediately wash their hands or use supplied hand sanitizer upon entering the clinic.
 - 🐾 Student turnaround time in the clinic should be no more than 15 minutes.
 - 🐾 Beginning of the year medication check-in dates will be August 25-26 from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm, and August 27 from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm. There will be a table set up in front of the gate by visitors parking.
 - 🐾 Parents checking in medication during the school year should call and set up an appointment time to check in medication. They will remain in the lobby and clinic staff will come to them to check in the medication. The number for the clinic is 850-689-7177 option 8.
 - 🐾 Parents bringing a one-time dose of medication for their student should remain in the lobby and the student will be called to them.
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
